

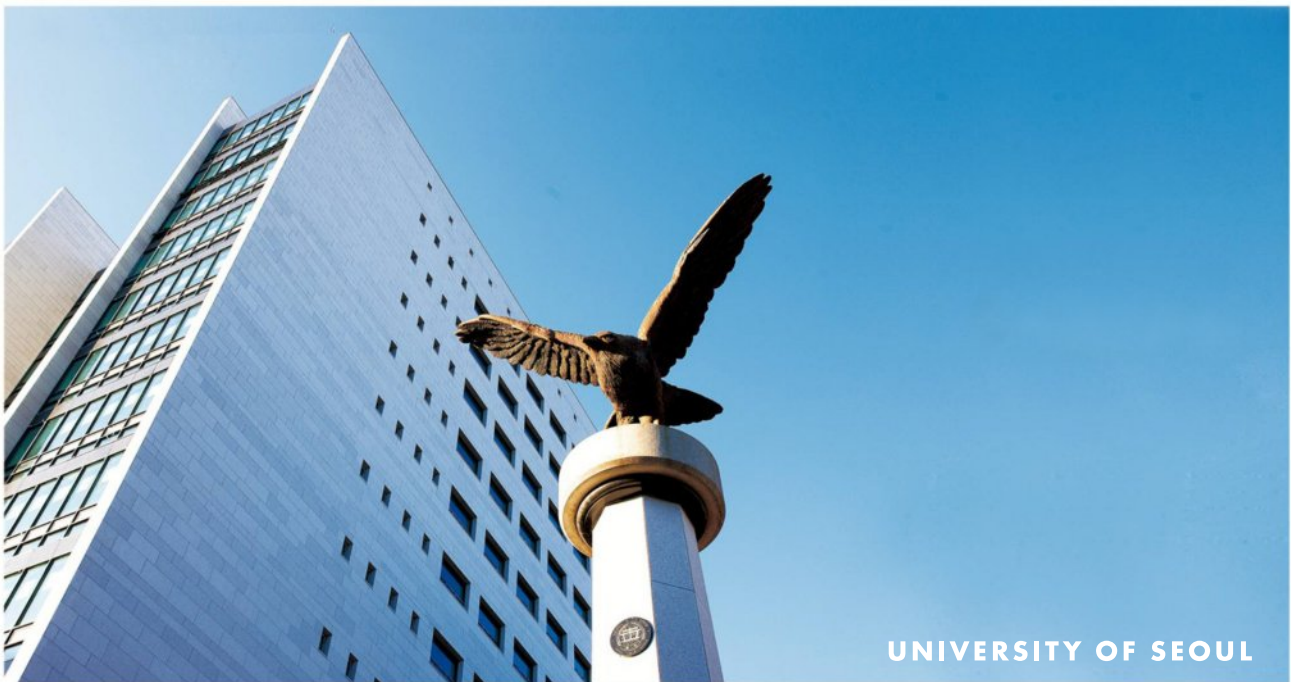

02 Student Exchange Program

Exchange students are those who have applied and are nominated by an overseas university under a formal exchange agreement. Exchange student candidates can apply through the international office of their home university. Tuition is paid to the home university, and in most cases, the application and documentation fee is waived. Students from UOS partner universities can apply for the UOS student exchange program. Applications should proceed with the approval of the international office of the students' home university.

Application Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Nominated students are required to complete UOS online application via the following site: https://wise.uos.ac.kr/application - Reference: OIA website (http://oia.uos.ac.kr) → For International Students → Study at UOS → Student Exchange Program → Application - What to submit on arrival <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) One official photo (3.5cm x 4.5cm, full color with white background) for alien registration (2) Certificate of Health, TB test result (or Chest X-ray) (it is a mandatory document only for on-campus housing residents and required to submit to housing office at check-in)

<p>Admission Requirements for Undergraduate</p>	<p>Undergraduate students should have completed at least two terms of university studies.</p>		
<p>Admission Requirements for Graduate students</p>	<p>UOS accepts international graduate students to graduate school as non-degree shortterm exchange students. However, all the courses offered at graduate level are taught in Korean. For the graduate students who are not fluent in Korean is strongly advised to be enrolled to undergraduate program. In this case, the student should ask his/her study abroad coordinator at the home university if this option would be accepted according to the university's policy.</p>		
<p>Conditions for choosing academic programs</p>	<p>Most of the departments or schools of UOS welcome exchange students. However, it is strongly recommended for exchange students to apply to their field of studies.</p>		
<p>Recommended credit points per semester</p>	<p>15 credits * Most courses are equivalent to 3 credits. * 1 credit = 15 class hours * A student should take at least 6 credits and can take up to 20 credits.</p>


2-5. Insurance & Certificate of Health



All international students are required to pay the 'Health Insurance Fee for Int'l Students' every month from alien registration date. </p> <p> Insurance Benefits (The same benefits as the Korean citizens) Various benefits are available, including dental and oriental medical treatment, health checkups, and pregnancy and childbirth related medical expenses. </p> <p> Enrollment Procedure No action is required from students, as they are automatically subscribed to health insurance by thy NHIS (National Health Insurance Service). </p>

04 Visiting Student Program

UOS provides various field of courses for international students from Partner University who is interested in spending their precious time in Korea up to a year.

The Visiting Student Program allows students from our Partner University who were not able to be nominated as exchange student, to be enrolled as one of UOS members and take opportunity to study at UOS campus.

<p>Eligibility & Requirements</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must have completed at least two semesters at home university when they participate the program. 2. A minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (GPA by US standard) or grades equivalent to a B average. 3. Must be a currently enrolled student from one of UOS Partner University 4. Must pay the tuition fee to the UIniveristy of Seoul 5. No language requirement. But applicant should have good command of wither Korean or English.
<p>Tution Fee & Application</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Tution Fee : From 2,156,000KRW ~ (depends on each department) * Application Process <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Submit online application & required documents - Deadline: May 31 (for Fall admission) & November 30 (for Spring admission)
