# How Can I Join?

**Eligibility** : Students enrolled at universities abroad as undergraduate or graduate students for the duration of the program. Applicants must have a passport valid for at least 6 months.

## Application Process

Students must complete the following **two-step application process**.

Please ensure that **Step 1 is completed before proceeding to Step 2**.

While the application procedure is the same for all students, **program fees are determined by the student's home university partnership status (institution type) and application date**.

### Step 1: [Create Your Account](#)

→ Create your UOS SISS ID to activate your personal dashboard.

→ During Step 1, students must select the **correct institution type to receive the appropriate partner discount**. If they are unsure about their home university's partnership status with UOS, they are advised to confirm with their home university's international office before proceeding.

### Step 2: [Complete Application](#)

→ Log in to your dashboard, upload required documents, and submit the application form.

→ To qualify for the **Early Bird Discount**, students must complete **both Step 1 and Step 2 by June 15**.

## Refund Policy

Please be advised that all refund requests must be submitted in writing to our Seoul International Summer School team. The registration fee is non-refundable. Refunds will be processed within 3-4 weeks of receipt of a valid request.

For tuition refunds, the following policies apply:

- If a student withdraws by July 29, 2026, which is one week prior to the start of the program, the tuition will be refunded less any commission fees or bank transaction charges.
- 50% of the tuition fee will be refundable for the request from July 30 to August 4, 2026, before the start of the program, less any commission fees or bank transaction charges.
- From the official start of the program, August 5, 2026, no refund will be available.
- A written notice of withdrawal must be made to the office before the deadlines stated above in order to receive the refund.
