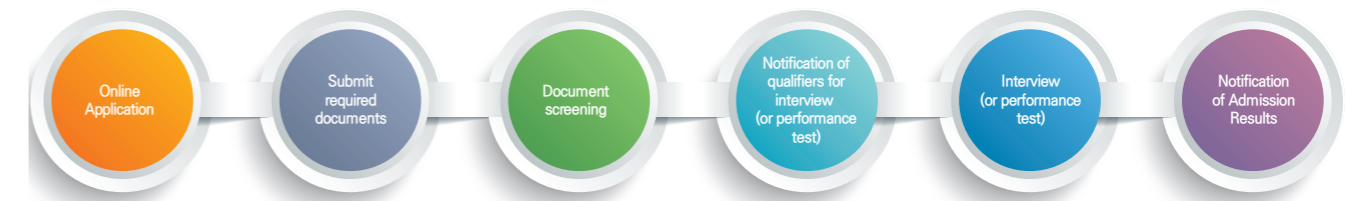

- ① The applicant and both parents must all have obtained only foreign citizenship by the date of application.
 - In the case of dual nationality, the applicant is recognized only if the applicant and both parents have all renounced their Korean nationality by the application start date.
- ② A foreign applicant or a Korean national residing abroad who has completed an education equivalent to that of Korean primary and secondary education and a Bachelor’s degree outside of Korea.
 - In case of ②, an applicant who has completed even one program at a Korean school during the entire history of education is not eligible to apply.

2) Academic background

※ Applicants’ academic degrees must be from official and authorized educational institutions recognized by the Ministry of Education of the applicant’s home country.

① Master’s degree: an applicant who holds any of the following qualifications:

- An applicant who has obtained a Bachelor’s degree or is expected to receive one before enrollment from a domestic or foreign university.
- An applicant who is recognized to have an academic background that is equivalent to the aforementioned one, according to Korean educational law.

② Doctoral degree: an applicant who holds any of the following qualifications:

- An applicant who has obtained a Master’s degree or is expected to receive one before enrollment from a domestic or foreign university.
- An applicant who is recognized to have an academic background that is equivalent to the aforementioned one, according to Korean educational law.

Application Fee

2) Payment method

- In case of the applicants who want to apply to a graduate program of Professional Graduate School or Special Graduate School, please refer to the respective admission guidelines.

1) Eligibility

- ① Applicants must meet all admissions requirements. (nationality, academic background and language proficiency)

2) Basic Notices for Submission of Documents

- ① After the online application is completed on the Uway Apply website, print out the UOS forms (letter of self-introduction, study plan, etc.) from the OIA webpage and submit all the required admission materials via post to the OIA office.
- ② All supporting documents must be originals.
- ③ All documents must be issued within 1 year of the deadline for online applications. (As for Bank Statement – within 30 days)
- ④ All documents must be written in Korean or English. Applicants who submit documents in languages other than Korean or English should attach notarized English or Korean translations of the original documents.
 - ※ Except in unavoidable cases, notarized translations must be done by authorized parties located in the country from which the documents originated.
 - ※ Arrange original hard copies before notarized translated ones.
 - ※ Applicants' personal translations will not be accepted.
- ⑤ The English spelling of the applicant's name on all documents must correspond to the spelling on the applicant's passport.
- ⑥ Submitted documents will not be returned. Application documents may be added or subtracted as required.
- ⑦ The applicant is responsible for any disadvantages caused by a mistake or omission in the documents. If the submitted documents don't meet the minimum requirement, the applicant will be excluded from the document evaluation process.
- ⑧ Submitted documents will not be returned. We encourage applicants to prepare enough additional documents for visa application in advance.

3) Admission Proceedings

- ① Please write your current contact details (phone number, email address, etc.) on the application form. The University of Seoul is not liable for any disadvantages caused by contact issues.
- ② Information on admission scores will not be disclosed.
- ③ For application forms and all submitted documents, if any falsifications, counterfeits, falsified statements, degrees from educational institution unauthorized by the Ministry of Education of the applicant's home country or other unjust actions are disclosed, the application will be rescinded. In case that such disclosures are identified, even after admission, the acceptance of admission will be canceled and paid tuition fees will not be refunded.

4) After Admission

- ① Among the applicants who have accepted admission, those who have not graduated by the time they apply or are expected to graduate after the admissions period must submit their final degree certificates and transcripts to an OIA coordinator before the semester starts. If the documents are not submitted, admission will be rescinded. This condition may be exceptionally laxed only if the time difference of academic schedule between applicant's nation and Korea is less than one month.
- ② After receiving a certificate of admission, if applicants residing outside Korea encounter difficulty obtaining a visa and fail to arrive in South Korea before class starts, admission will be rescinded automatically and the certificate of admission will be invalidated.
- ③ After the final admission process, the OIA may request submission of academic records from an applicant's highest-level-school based on the Agreement of Academic Records Request submitted by the applicant. In the case that the confirmation certificate is not received within six months, applicants must contact the schools they graduated from themselves to assure, submission of the official academic records. If the school fails to submit the applicant's official academic records, admission will be rescinded.

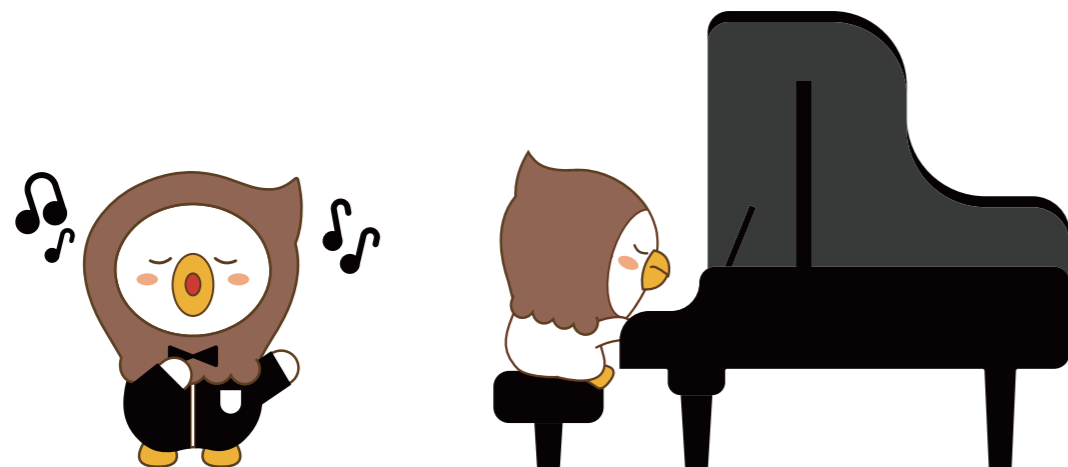

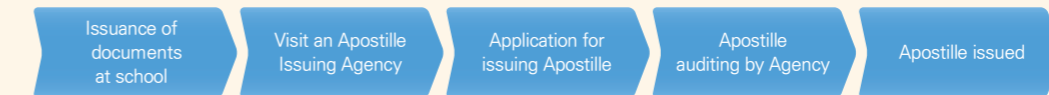
